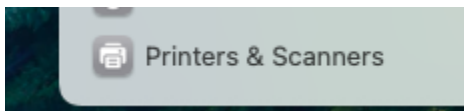
Manually adding a printer to your MAC computer

3. Download and install the driver.

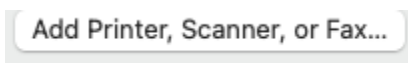
Open the Settings Menu on your MAC



Click on Printers & Scanners menu






