1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to define CMRR's patient and volunteer gowning requirements.

2. Scope

This policy will apply to all human scans taking place at CMRR.

3. Responsibility

It is the responsibility of all personnel who perform the functions listed in Section 2 to adhere to this policy.

It is the responsibility of the owner/author listed above to review the content of this policy for accuracy and continued applicability on at least an annual basis.

4. Policy

All research subjects and patients, except in a limited number of cases, are required to wear CMRR-provided scrubs or gowns during MR scans. Policy exemptions will only be made for study populations whose physical or mental status make changing into scrubs/gowns a significant burden.

Gowning Process

The MR Safety Screener is required to ask a subject/patient to change into a gown or scrubs before starting a scan. Subjects/patients are allowed to wear personal undergarments, but the MR Safety Screener is required to ask whether undergarments are anti-odor or contain glittery material. In affirmative cases, the undergarments must be removed or the scan cancelled. The MR Safety Screener will inform women of the possibility of heating and/or movement of metal in the underwire or clasps of bras.

Designated changing rooms with lockers can be found throughout the building (1-122, 1-206E, 1-302A). These rooms cannot be reserved and should only be used for changing. Rooms that can be reserved for consenting or experimental tasks can also be used as changing rooms (1-143, 1-206C, 1-206D, 1-123), but **should not be reserved for changing purposes**. Restrooms and curtained areas near the 3T's (1-135 and 1-120K) can also be used as changing rooms as needed.

Scrubs (sizes s-xl) are located in each changing room and are stocked daily. Child-sized, xxl, and xxl scrubs are housed in the central linen supply closet outside of the 7T/AS.

Policy Exemption Request Process

Policy exemptions are reviewed and approved by the CMRR Safety Committee on a study by study basis. Exemption requests, along with justifications should be sent to Jeramy Kulesa (ande2445@umn.edu). Exemptions will not be made for healthy volunteers.
